- Why is he a servant of all? V19

- What is his motivation in all this? 9v23, 10v31,33

# All things to All People for the Sake of the Gospel

- NOT "as a jew I try to become like a gentile" !!
- BUT as a gospel-man, as a Jesus-follower I become like a jew to reach jews, like a gentile to reach gentiles
- Our identity in Christ super-cedes every other 'identity' we have if we are 'gospel-people'.
- What does that mean/look like in practice?

### All things to all people

#### A willingness:

- To put my personal like/dislikes to one side
- To put no unnecessary barriers/stumbling blocks before unbelievers EXCEPT the offence of the gospel
- To put myself out for the sake of the other
- 1 Cor 10:31-33

### Before the Service

- Pray Sat night/ Sunday morning Read the passage
   Do I go to the service eg evening service
- What time do I arrive?
- Where do I sit?
- Do I 'look out' for others?

Sidespeople/Welcomers

- Welcome (sensitive to people's body language
  Names better to risk offence than ignore
- Show to seat? Creche, Sunday Club, Sparks
- Introduce to others/explain the service

## **During the Service**

- The importance of comfort how would you/do you treat a visitor to your home?
- Good technology
- Good music and 'heartfelt' worship
- Service that is accessible (but not 'dumbed-down')
- The Importance of Explanations careful about 'inhouse' comments

#### After the Service

- Don't speak to the vicar!!
- Do stay and come through to the hall
- Invite and accompany new people
- Introduce to others
- Look for people who are new/on their own
- Serve good quality refreshments free!!!
- Talk about the service/sermon
